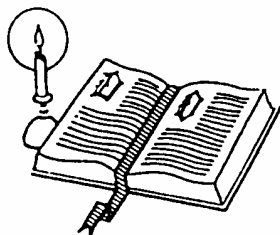

**FROM FATHER MARK'S DESK**

Dear Friends,

I hope you noticed! Last weekend, for the first time in many months, the bell in our bell tower pealed the familiar call to worship before each of our weekend Masses. Since November 5, when the bell was repaired, our neighborhood has also been serenaded with the Angelus, which is struck at 6:00 a.m., Noon, and 6:00 p.m. The cost of the repairs was slightly under \$10,000.00 and was made possible by donations from the Shaheen family, the estate of Ed McGarry and another anonymous donor from our parish. Thank you for your generosity and the beautiful ringing of our church bell!

Once again, with the generous giving of parishioners which restored our church bell, we have an example of stewardship in action. Stewardship is about giving regardless as to whether it is a gift of time, talent or treasure. Stewardship encompasses all three, because all three are gifts to us from God. As a spirituality, stewardship involves the recognition that we have a need to give because we realize that God has generously given to us. Who among us, if we won millions in the lottery, would not be moved to share this gift with family at least if not others as well? That's what stewardship is like. The steward recognizes that God has blessed us with much in the way of time, talent and treasure. The gratitude that we then feel moves us to share with others our gifts from God. Please review the Time, Talent, Treasure form that you received in the mail and fill it out as a family. Even if you turned it in last year, remember that this is a renewal. Please fill it out carefully, and place it in the collection basket next weekend, November 22/23, Stewardship Renewal Weekend. Give stewardship a try!
